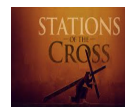

**Come Celebrate Women At The Well's 20th Anniversary with a Leapin' Leprechauns' Bunco Bash**

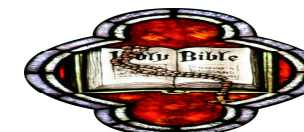
