Communion with the Body and Blood of Christ increase the communicant's union with the Lord, forgives his venial sins, and preserves him from grave sins. 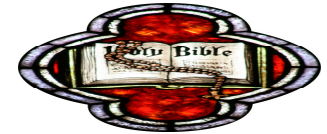
