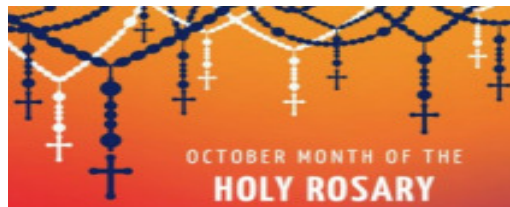

"For the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many." (MARK 10:45)

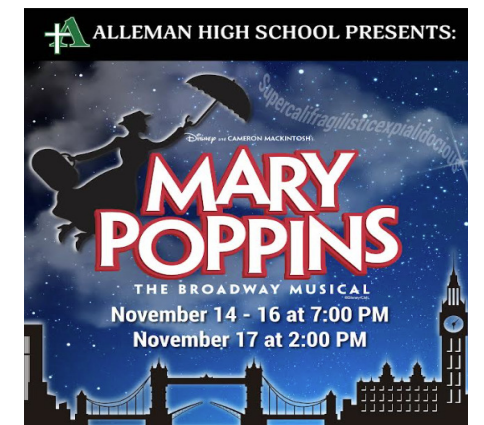
