The promise of the Eucharist is first mentioned in Chapter 6 of St. John's Gospel. It is interesting to note that this promise comes right after two miracles, reported in the same chapter, which show Jesus' power over nature. The two miracles are the multiplication of the loaves and the miracle of His walking on the water across the Sea of Tiberias. In this way Jesus prepared His disciples to accept the great Eucharistic mystery. He who had the power to multiply loaves and to walk on water would also have the power to change bread and wine into His body and Blood.

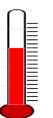
