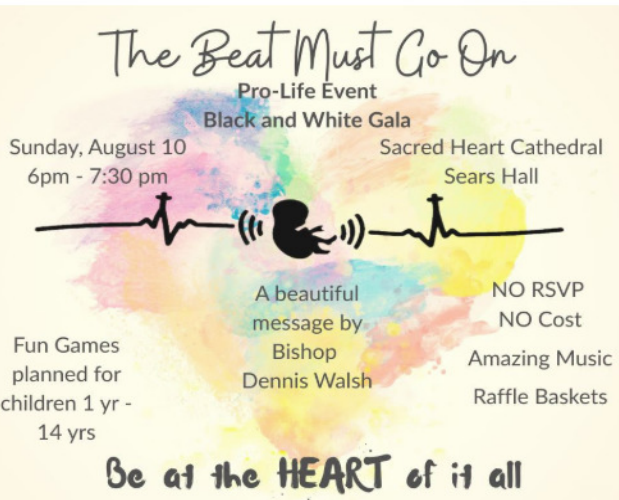
"Take care to guard against all greed, for though one may be rich, one's life does not consist of possessions." LUKE 12:15
